



The kitchen-garden at Österbybruk's Manor was built in the 18th century and was in operation continuously until the 1970s.

Unfortunately deterioration went quickly when the business ceased. Left was mostly nettles and broken glass, but also the garden's original shape and wall that extends along the western border.

The 7300 m2 area is now more cultivated and thriving. The restoration work has not only applied to the ground. The buildings, electricity, and irrigation have been renovated with the help of contributions from all over.

Thanks to the non-profit work and memberships, we have come a long way in our quest to show how the kitchen-garden may have looked during the manors's glory days.

Österbybruk as a tourist destination, the garden is an important part of the historical heritage and is quite an oasis to roam.
